general george s patton old blood and guts is the biography of general george s patton a leading u s army general in world war ii in campaigns in north africa sicily france and germany 1943 1945 during world war i patton was a senior commander of the new tank corps and saw action in france after the war he was an advocate of armored

prime minister winston churchill crossed the rhine river on march 25th 1945 his presence was calculated to emphasize the british role in the defeat of the germans and to divert attention away from patton and the americans who had crossed the rhine at remagen two weeks earlier supreme allied commander dwight eisenhower had warned his commanders that churchill would seek to steal the limelight eisenhower ordered his commanders to refuse any requests to cross the rhine the answer must be no but when eisenhower and bradley left the prime minister seized his chance this photograph caught the moment and was printed on the front page of newspapers around the world once again the wily prime minister had captured the world s attention at the expense of the americans the joint american canadian and british operation appeared to be primarily a triumph of british arms eisenhower bradley and patton were furious eisenhower could do nothing about the prime minister but he never forgave the american generals involved and general eisenhower had other things on his mind it took ten years and

an act of congress for general william simpson to receive the fourth star due him as commanding general of the us ninth army major general john b anderson still waits his third star as commanding general us xvi corps in the meantime general in command the life of major general john b anderson is his triumphant story from the iowa cornfields to command of the largest combat corps in europe in the second world war

more than killing patton a reviewer this is the story of the life and mind of george c marshall soldier and statesman as told by a distinguished writer whose own background makes him particularly qualified to discuss some of the more controversial aspects of general marshall s work since world war ii showing in quite an extraordinary way how marshall represents the strengths and weaknesses of the american tradition this book s study of the life of a great contemporary american illuminates the american scene with an insight rarely equalled in a biographical work the marshall story is neither a white wash of general marshall nor an attack on him his errors of judgment are studied at some length partly because the same pattern of behavior is visible in each of these errors but chiefly because the consequences of error were disastrous but against these errors are set his triumphs the first a personal one the others impersonal and prodigiously important because they affected the conduct of the war and the conduct of the peace his generalship and the marshall plan in this book robert payne s subject is a man who has been described by president harry s truman as the greatest living american and payne s treatment of the subject makes the marshall story a study of a man who knew exactly where he was going went there made mistakes and seemed perhaps not to belong to our own time this book will shatter some illusions about george c marshall but it will also place him in the perspective of his time and demonstrate that he may be even greater than many of us have thought him to be robert payne 1911 1983 was born in cornwall u k his father was english his mother french he was educated at st paul s school in london and at the universities of liverpool capetown in south africa munich and the sorbonne during his lifetime he had over a hundred books published on a wide range of subjects the widest range of any known author he was known chiefly for his biographies and history books among them hitler lenin stalin gandhi leonardo chaplin the christian centuries the world of art he also wrote novels and poetry librarians loved him critics raved about him orville prescott of the new york times referred to him as a literary phenomenon of astounding versatility and industry

united states army his participation in the mexican war and other events are detailed before the main body of the book focuses on the american civil war era after turning down an offer to head up the union army lee resigned his commission and offered his services to his home state of virginia and the confederate states of america from there his meteoric rise to commander in chief and personal leader of the army of northern virginia the confederacy s most powerful army is told in gripping detail each event unfolds in the narrative as its subject would have experienced it himself providing a continually fresh perception of the terrible events of 1861 to 1865 at first serving as a senior military adviser to confederate president jefferson davis lee was appointed commander of the army of northern virginia in june 1862 after his predecessor was wounded lee s first great victory warding off an attack on the confederate capital of richmond cemented his tenure and thereafter followed four years of ebb and flow of great and bloody events including the second battle of bull run the invasion of maryland the battles of antietam fredericksburg chancellorsville gettysburg the wilderness spotsylvania and the siege of petersburg finally overcome by superior numbers nearly out of supplies and his great army reduced to just 26 000 men lee was finally forced to surrender in april 1865 effectively ending the war the value of this work lies not in the description of the battles themselves but rather in the personal perception provided by seeing them through lee s eyes in this vein the final section of the book provides an overview of the last five years of the general s life including a highly elucidating interview on the topics of the day completely reset contains all 25 original illustrations digitally restored to better than original and a short biography of the author
