austrian composer alban berg 1885 1935 composed the three act opera wozzeck between 1914 and 1922 after seeing a production of german playwright georg büchner s incomplete drama woyzeck beginning the work in 1914 including the adaptation of büchner s text into a libretto berg s obsession with completing the opera was interrupted by his serving in the austro hungarian army from 1915 to 1918 and during world war i an experience which significantly altered his approach to wozzeck the plot which depicts the lives of the inhabitants and soldiers of a rural german speaking town follows the title character as he is abused by the soldiers and deals with the infidelity of his wife who he eventually murders before drowning himself the opera ends with wozzeck s son obliviously continuing to play with the other children as word of his murdered mother begins to spread the opera finally premiered by the berlin state opera erich kleiber conducting on december 14 1925 eleven years after berg began work it is considered the first avant garde opera and it famously employs atonality and sprechgesang although it does make use of leitmotifs and some classic forms to create some unity and coherence throughout the music and plot the opera is performed often in both staged and concert settings instrumentation 4 4 4th deh 4 bcl 3 cbsn 4 4 4 1 timp 2 perc 3 4 clst hp str 4 4 3 3 3 in set banda 3 banda configurations used but all banda players may be pulled from the pit orchestra onstg pno vocal soli 12 roles strebleattttbarbarbarbb mixed choir

possesses profound cultural and historical significance and as an art form that can be world disclosive formative of subjectivity and contributive to intersubjective relations music and ethics does not offer a general musico ethical theory but explores ethics as a practical concept and demonstrates through concrete examples that the relation between music and ethics has never been absent

headlam closely analyzes berg s compositional technique and the use of symmetry and cycles throughout his oeuvre he brings into the discussion berg s own writings as well as those of composer and musicologist george perle the techniques of schoenberg webern and other serialists and aspects of pitch class set and twelve tone theory

perle s contribution in both domains the analytical and the biographical have their original and primary impetus in his studies of the lyric suite a work that has preoccupied him since 1937 this pendragon edition brings the wealth of his earlier writings on the lyric suite together for the first time and includes in addition new material on the quartet s history new analytical observations and a comparative study of the sketches and drafts that allows the reader to convert the currently published score into an authoritatively corrected edition book jacket

a multi volume set giving detailed information on every aspect of opera over 100 000 entries improves on steiger s opernlexikon by including two additional data categories for each work language of text and literary sources and by covering composers who have appeared since the end date of steiger s work 1934

this book combines meticulous scholarship with a lightness of touch that will delight the opera goer the fascinating illustrations bring an amusing dimension showing how opera has been staged from its beginnings to modern deconstructed productions the operas are listed in alphabetical order in addition to a full synopsis of every plot there is a cast list and a note of the singers in the original production as well as information about the origins of the work and its literary and social background each contribution concludes with a brief comment on its place in operatic history there is also a listing by composer a glossary and indexes of the names of operatic characters and the first lines of arias so if you are not sure which opera gilda or agathe sings in or are apt to confuse vespina with despina your problem is quickly solved

this is the first detailed assessment of berg the man and composer in any language its greater part is devoted to a critical analysis of berg s music and to a thorough appraisal of the achievements of arnold schoenberg and its two chief disciples but it is also a comprehensive biography of the man alban berg and much additional biographical matter is included in the analytical portions of the book in two long chapters the author discusses the operas wozzeck and lulu at length using musical

examples and hitherto unpublished letters the chapter on lulu contains the first detailed analysis of act 3 which was completed in short score but not completely orchestrated and which remains unperformed to this day works which have been neglected by musicologists so far such as the altenberg songs the storm lieder and the chamber concerto are fully analyzed as such in the development of serial composition

in this second volume of selections from the author s journalism the maverick english composer directs his enquiring mind at the music being composed in france germany italy and elsewhere in the first half of the twentieth century richard strauss figures prominently among the composers discussed beginning with reviews of hallé and queen s hall concerts in 1907 and 1910 but even strauss was not treated as lavishly as another whose music clearly fascinated the author clearly arnold schoenberg from gurrelieder to the violin concerto the author emerges as one of schoenberg s most sympathetic and understanding champions among the english critical fraternity in the inter war period other composers featured include bartók berg busoni debussy dohnányi dukas glazunov grieg hindemith kilpinen lehár mahler messenger puccini rachmaninov ravel respighi shostakovich sibelius sousa stravinsky szzymanowski tailleferre and varèse as well as figures now obscure such as alfred bruneau august bungert césar géloso and wilhelm kienzl among the author s writings on american music a selection of which rounds off the book is an interview with the march king john philip sousa whose music the author wholeheartedly enjoyed over 160 different items written over the four decades between 1907 and 1945 articles reviews and extracts from the author s column on the other hand in musical opinion make up this volume the author s open mind makes him an illuminating and entertaining guide to the music he is writing about the editor s introductions and annotations provide the background to each piece and cast light on the author s more obscure references
